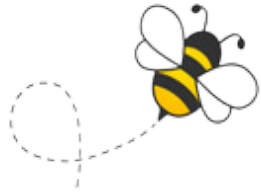

Instructions

REGISTRATION DEADLINE

May 15, 2026

PAYMENTS:

All camps are \$150 for Half Day and \$300 for Full Day unless indicated otherwise in the camp description.

Morning Session is from 8:30 a.m.-11:30 a.m. and Afternoon Session is from 12 pm-3 pm.

All Camp Payments will be charged through your families TADS account. Cash and Check, addressed to Erie Day School, will be accepted at the front office. Do not submit payments directly to teachers.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

- If you cancel at least two weeks before the camp start date, you will receive a 50% refund of your camp fee issued back to your TADS account.
- Cancellations made within two weeks of the camp start date are non-refundable.

PICK-UP:

- Parents/guardians must pick up campers promptly at the end of each session, unless the camper is attending two consecutive sessions.
- If your child is enrolled in both a morning and an afternoon session, pick-up will be at the conclusion of the second session.

LUNCH:

Erie Day School's Summer Camps do not provide lunch for campers attending both a morning and afternoon session. Please pack a lunch and beverage for your child. Lunch supervision will be provided from 11:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

REGISTRATION & REFUNDS:

- Registration and payment are required to secure your camper's spot. This allows us to purchase supplies and plan accordingly.
- The camp instructor reserves the right to cancel any camp due to low enrollment. In such cases, all registered participants will be notified, and a full refund will be issued to your TADS account.
- If a participant withdraws at least two weeks before the camp start date, a 50% refund will be issued.
- No refunds will be given for cancellations made within two weeks of the camp start date.

HOW TO REGISTER:

- Check the box next to the camp(s) you wish to enroll your student(s) in on the Sign Up page. Indicate the number of camps AND the total payment on that page.
- Submit one Sign Up page per child.
- Print and return the Sign Up page along with the Camper Information Sheet to the Erie Day School front office. This page can be emailed to mmccaslin@eriedayschool.com. Registration is not complete until payment is made.

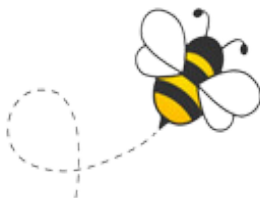
Forensic Science Detective Camp | August 3-7

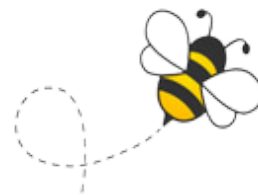

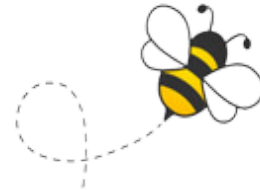
