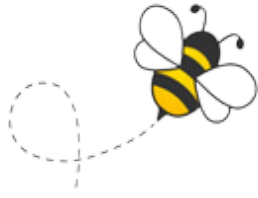

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: May 15, 2025

PAYMENTS:

Please make checks payable directly to the camp instructor. The registration fee has been included in your total camp cost.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

- If you cancel at least two weeks before the camp start date, you will receive a 50% refund of your camp fee from the camp instructor.
- Cancellations made within two weeks of the camp start date are non-refundable.

PICK-UP:

- Parents/guardians must pick up campers promptly at the end of each session, unless the camper is attending two consecutive sessions.
- If your child is enrolled in both a morning and an afternoon session, pick-up will be at the conclusion of the second session.

LUNCH:

Erie Day School's Summer Camps do not provide lunch for campers attending both a morning and afternoon session. Please pack a lunch and beverage for your child. Lunch supervision will be provided from 11:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

REGISTRATION & REFUNDS:

- Registration and payment are required to secure your camper's spot. This allows us to purchase supplies and plan accordingly.
- The camp instructor reserves the right to cancel any camp due to low enrollment. In such cases, all registered participants will be notified, and a full refund will be issued.
- If a participant withdraws at least two weeks before the camp start date, a 50% refund will be issued.
- No refunds will be given for cancellations made within two weeks of the camp start date.

- Check the box next to the camp(s) you wish to enroll your student(s) in.
- Complete the required information in the camp description.
- Print and return the relevant brochure pages along with the Camper Information Sheet to the Erie Day School front office.

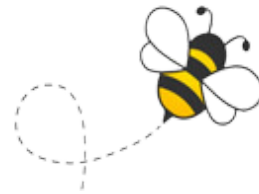
