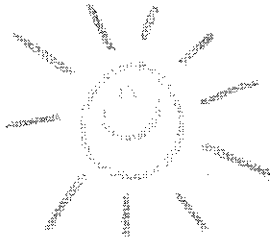


Toddler Supply List

1. Two boxes of tissues. (CUBE STYLE ONLY)
2. Three containers of disinfecting wipes.
3. Three packages of wipes. (All toddlers use these daily on faces after snack and lunch)
4. Three full boxes of diapers, if your child uses them. (NO PULL-UPS)
5. Two complete extra changes of clothes for cubby basket. (shirts, pants, underwear, socks and an extra pair of shoes) When your child is learning to use the toilet, we may ask you to send more or will let you know when things are low.
6. A family photo to be hung in our classroom, pets included!
7. Water bottle
8. Full day children- a lunch box and containers that are easy for them to open. The children will put their food on a plate just like you do at home, and they are encouraged to do that as independently as possible. (NO BENTO BOXES)
9. Full day children- a toddler sized NAPMAT that rolls up. We will send them home periodically on Fridays to wash and return the following Monday.
10. Any additional items that you would like to donate to enrich our classroom this school year is ALWAYS appreciated. THANK YOU.

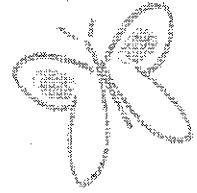
You may bring these items to your individual meeting, the back to school night or after the start of school!

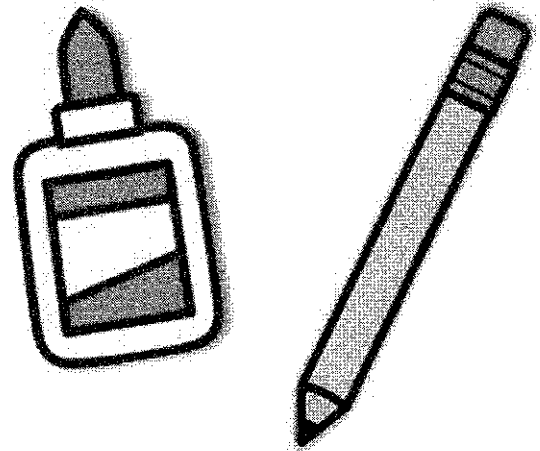
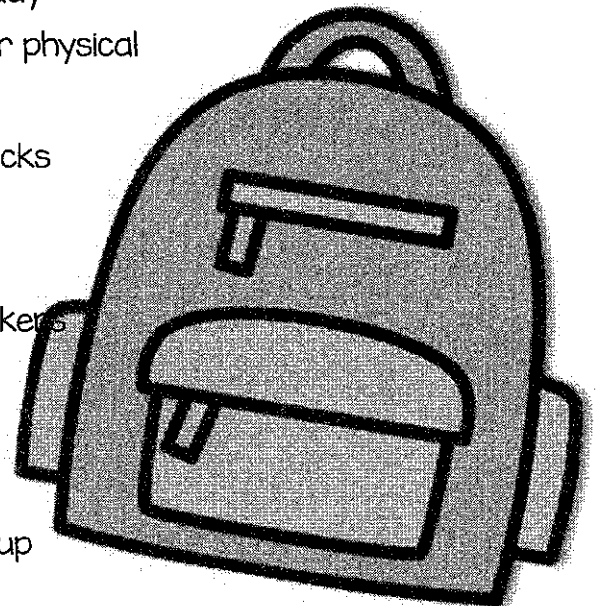

2025-2026 SCHOOL YEAR

The following are a list of required and optional supplies. All students must have the required supplies. Thank you! ☺

Required

- A labeled plastic shoebox (no larger, please) filled with seasonal appropriate clothing (2 pairs of pants, 2 shirts, 3 pairs of underwear, and 2 pairs of socks)
- A backpack labeled inside with your child's name (the backpack should be large enough to hold a folder and your child's lunchbox)
- A labeled water bottle to bring to school each day
- One pair of Velcro sneakers to be worn daily for physical activities
- One (1) pack of Elmer's brand giant sized glue sticks
- One (1) pair of scissors
- Two (2) packs of 24 count Crayola crayons
- Two (2) packs of Crayola brand thin tipped markers
- Two (2) packs of Crayola brand thick tipped markers
- Three (3) boxes of tissues
- A labeled resting mat that can be easily folded up
- Labeled lunch box with a freezer pack
- Three (3) containers of disinfecting wipes
- One (1) box of plastic forks
- One (1) box of plastic spoons

KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST

2026-27

- A change of seasonally appropriate clothing (stored in a medium sized plastic shoebox with child's name on the outside. Will be stored under backpacks in the hallway.)
 - Pants, shirt, underwear, socks
 - I recommend that all "extra clothing" follow our uniform guidelines.
- A backpack
 - large enough to hold a standard 12"x 6" folder
- A small blanket and small stuffed animal for "rest-time"
 - The blanket and stuffed animal should be packed inside a bag that can easily be transported to and from home.
- A pair of Velcro sneakers
 - to be worn during Physical Education or throughout the entire day
 - If your child is capable of independently tying their own shoes, they may wear tie shoes.
- One healthy snack for morning
 - Please label, "A.M" snack to eliminate confusion with lunch items
 - Snack break is 10-15 minutes long. Please send one snack item for your child that can be eaten in allotted amount of time
 - Nut-free items only please (items that resemble peanut butter should be labeled "Nut-free")
- A water bottle that will be sent home at the end of each day to be washed and returned to school the following day.
- Play dough 4pk set
- Lunchbox, utensils to use as needed, cloth napkin (recommended)
- We HIGHLY recommend purchasing a hot/cold Thermos for food items that need to be heated. (Your child will be eating lunch in the dining room along with two other grades. Therefore, there is not a lot of time to heat items in the microwave.)

Art Supplies will be kept inside each child's "Art Box"

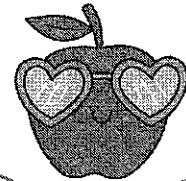

- An art box that will hold child's art supplies. (Art boxes will contain sharpened pencils, pink pearl erasers, crayons, colored pencils and/or markers, scissors, glue sticks, and EXPO markers.) All supplies that do not fit inside our art boxes will be kept in storage bins on our shelves.)
- Crayola colored pencils (a box of 12)
- Dry Erase Markers (EXPO, Fine Tip, pack of 4)
- One pair of scissors
- Markers (washable, 10 pack, assorted colors)
- Crayons (a box of at least 12 crayons, assorted colors)
- A 12pack of #2 Pre-sharpened Ticonderoga Wooden Pencils

2026 5th Grade Supply List

Please send in the following supplies in a large box or bag labeled with your child's name. No need to label individual items; we will create labels and organize supplies in class.

Payne: Homeroom/Social Studies/ELA/Math

These supplies are to be kept in the fifth grade classroom or in your student's locker:

- 3 boxes of tissues
- 1 container of sanitizing wipes
- 2 rolls paper towels
- 1 small bottle of hand sanitizer
- 20 (or more) black ballpoint pens (not erasable)
- 1 pack of gel pens in a variety of colors for notes, corrections, and proofreading
- 2 boxes of #2 Ticonderoga pencils
- 1 handheld manual pencil sharpener
- 3 packs of Post-Its (original size)
- 1 box of 24-count Crayola colored pencils
- 1 box 10-count Crayola broad-tip markers
- 1 box 10-count Crayola fine-tip markers
- 1 box of highlighters (at least 3 different colors, please)
- 1 zippered pencil case/pouch large enough to hold several pens, pencils, highlighters, and a pack of Post-Its
- 1 pair of adult-sized scissors
- 1 6-qt. clear plastic storage box with lid
- 1 pack reinforcement stickers for loose leaf paper
- 1 plastic accordion folder that fastens closed
- 6 packs of wide-ruled loose-leaf paper
- 3 two-pocket, three-hole folders that can be inserted in binder rings (1 purple, 1 green, and 1 blue)
- 3 three-ring 1" binders with clear plastic pocket cover
- 1 wide-ruled composition notebook
- 1 set of five plastic binder dividers with tabs (not paper, please)
- 4 packs of 3x5 index cards (lined on one side)
- 2 plastic index card boxes
- 1 Texas Instruments TI-30X calculator
- 1 Metric/standard ruler
- 1 locker shelf OR plastic storage drawer console—our lockers have an opening that is 12" wide and they are 15" wide inside
- OPTIONAL: Students may bring in small locker decorations, such as a mirror or magnetic storage for small items. Please keep in mind that an overabundance of locker decorations makes it very difficult for fifth graders to keep their lockers neat and organized

ENGLISH – Mrs. Filbeck

- * 1" binder with clear view cover, used only for English (this can be used for more than one year)
- * 1 set 5-tab dividers for three ring binders
- * 2 packs notebook paper
- * 1 two-pocket folder (used only for English)
- * 250 – 3x5 WHITE sturdy index cards (ruled lines on the front & blank on the back)
- * 1 recipe box for index cards (or index card holder)
